

Lab Safety Drawing

You and your table partner are responsible for drawing a few lab safety rules. Inside your envelope will be different, but related safety rules. For this assignment, you will draw your lab safety rule being done correctly.

Here are the requirements:

1. The drawing must be in color.
2. The drawing must include the rule written on it somewhere, large enough to be read a few feet away (so no small handwriting!)
3. The drawing must be appropriate.

To get started:

1. Read your rules and make sure you understand them.
2. Make a simple sketch of what you plan to do. Show it to Mr. Ower for approval. The sketch does not need to be in color; just a layout of what you are planning.
3. Work on your actual drawing.

Each team of students will present their lab safety rule. It is important that you understand the rule as the rest of the class will be taking notes based on what you say! Therefore, you must know what your rule is and why it is important. You will only be allowed to have your drawing with you when you share with the class.

The picture will be due by the **middle of your class on Tuesday**. Presentations will start after that.
